Opening

The meeting of the California Invasive Species Advisory Committee (CISAC) was called to order at 10:00 a.m. on October 25, 2022 held at the California Department of Food and Agriculture (CDFA).

Chair Martha Volkoff welcomed committee members, guests and staff.

COMMITTEE BUSINESS

All CISAC members and guests gave updates, including discussion on: the Western Regional Panel; California Pest Council meetings; the Cal-IPC Symposium; Oak Symposium; Landscape Expo; Bark Beetle Academy; the California Agricultural Commissioners and Sealers Association (CACASA) annual meeting; a League of Cities event; the Farm-to-Fork event; International Sportsmen's Expo; arborist workshops; and an interagency spotted lanternfly action group.

PRESENTATIONS Request for Proposal Presentation

Martha Volkoff stated that Stephen Tachiera presented a sample Request for Proposal (RFP) draft at the July 2022 CISAC meeting. The Grants Process Subcommittee met twice to refine the RFP language, including making the language more inclusive to all CISAC member agency interests. The revised RFP draft was presented to the Committee and further adjusted to:

- Not unfairly advantage existing programs
- Clarify project length and fund matching
- Vendors should have a presentation for deliverables
- Potentially allowing specific expenses, with approval
- Specifying project and applicant eligibility
- Adjusted applicant information and project narrative
- Adding submission tutorial

Weed Management Area Recommendation Reallocation

Jordan Key delivered a synopsis of the San Diego *Volutaria* program. He explained *Volutaria* impacts land value agriculture, reducing crop yield, consuming water and the superblooms could lower biodiversity. They have been using funding from CDFA, San Diego Association of Governments and the county public works department. The funding would be used to eliminate populations in highly-trafficked areas.

David Pegos stated that the previous CISAC meeting, \$1,000,000 was set aside for the two-year *Volutaria* project. Jordan Key can only allocate \$250,000 for that program. It was suggested that the remaining \$750,000 be evenly allocated to the remaining projects that can use it. Alternative suggestions were presented.

Motion: To approve the reallocation of the \$750,000 originally allocated to the *Volutaria* program to the other shovel-ready California Invasive Species Advisory Committee projects.
