David Pegos stated that CISAC would be looking to utilize California State University, Sacramento as facilitator/moderators for the Invasive Species Summit and Tours. Shannon Lynch provided an interactive map of possible tour locations. The merits of key locations for each tour were discussed, including partnering with the University of California Cooperative Extension, County Agricultural Commissioners, and Resource Conservation Districts who would be experts in local opportunities to showcase California agriculture, natural resources, and invasive pests that threaten their local ecosystem. The expectation is for 110 participants to attend the tour events. Staff would provide two buses and hotel blocks to accommodate them. It was suggested that the tours be pushed to the fall quarter to have more time to work on logistics.

Outreach Subcommittee executives will be populating an attendee participant list and adding more map locations. They will create a JotForm to reach out to participants who can offer valuable viewpoints to the tour groups, examples include Committee staff, nature conservancy, Audubon, nursery and agriculture representatives.
